



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS: POST ACCEPTANCE

I am a finalist. Does this mean I'll receive a scholarship?

Not necessarily. All finalists must follow the post-acceptance process to have the self-reported information verified. Finalists will either be awarded or denied based on this final evaluation.

What type of information is required?

Every finalist must provide an official, recent transcript, and a course registration.

How do I know if my application and required documents have been received?

If the **Cobell-OASIS** system allows you to submit your application, the file has been received. However, this does not mean that IE staff can view it. If staff cannot view the file, you will receive an email communication from an IE staff member to fix the error.

Are there any other requirements once a scholarship is offered?

The Post-Acceptance process requires finalists to meet deadlines prior to making an award final. Before finalizing an award, IE asks finalists to upload transcripts from the prior terms, a schedule of courses to verify enrollment, a photo to share, and respond to a short questionnaire.

What is an Honorary Scholar?

IE will invite selected students who meet all eligibility but do not have an unmet need to become an Honorary Cobell Scholar. Honorary Scholars are invited to attend webinar information sessions, and to have access to resources, support and other opportunities as they become available; however, honorary scholars will not be receiving a monetary award for the specified academic period.

What are other aids and resources available as a Cobell Scholarship Recipient?

Cobell Scholars will receive messages of encouragement, academic support and guidance, social engagement, and a variety of educational resources and opportunities. IE is also investigating a Scholar Conference to which scholars may be invited.

If I receive the scholarship will I be awarded every year?

The Cobell Scholarship is not automatically renewed. Scholars must apply and go through the selection process each year. Academic excellence will always be a priority for selection.

Can my scholarship be rescinded?

IE reserves the right to take back the offer if a student no longer has an unmet need, does not meet the minimum GPA requirement, fails to complete the Post Acceptance process or falsifies an application.

When will I get my check? Indigenous Education, Inc. will send the award check directly to the institution from which we received the Financial Need Analysis form. Finalists must complete the post-acceptance form and required documents in their entirety prior to becoming officially awarded. It will take roughly 2-3 weeks after you receive an email specifying that you have officially been awarded the Cobell Scholarship. Please check with your institution regarding their financial aid distribution process.
